**DATA ON OXYGEN BEDS IN INDIA**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the current total number of oxygen beds available in the country's hospitals
- (b) the number of oxygen beds added between March 2020 till date
- (c) the total number of ventilator beds available in the country and
- (d) the number of ventilator beds added between March 2020 till date?

**ANSWER

(a) to (d): As reported by states, as on 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2021 a total of 4,25,981 oxygen supported isolation beds are available for managing COVID-19 in the country. Further, as on 21<sup>st</sup> April 2020 a total of 62,458 oxygen supported isolation beds were available for managing COVID-19 in the country.

Similarly, states have reported availability of 57,518 ventilator beds as on 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2021 for managing COVID-19 cases in the country. Further, as on 30<sup>th</sup> March 2020 a total of 14,440 ventilator beds were available for managing COVID-19 in the country.
