**DEVELOPMENT OF AIRPORTS UNDER UDAN SCHEME IN UTTAR
PRADESH**

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) the number of airports identified for development under UDAN scheme in various parts of the country including Uttar Pradesh; and
- (b) the number of developed airports along with the progress made and status of the same?

(a) & (b): Airports Authority of India (AAI), the implementing agency, has identified 113 Regional Connectivity Scheme(RCS) airports including 14 water aerodromes & 33 helipads for operation of RCS flights till four rounds of bidding under RCS-UDAN(Ude Desh Ka Aam Nagrik). Out of these 113 airports, 17 UDAN airports, namely, Agra, Aligarh, Prayagraj, Bareilly, Kanpur, Chitrakoot, Ayodhaya, Gazipur, Jhansi, Moradabad, Kushinagar, Meerut, Muirpur, Azamgarh, Shravasti, Saharanpur & Hindon have been identified in Uttar Pradesh(UP). As on date, 59 RCS Airports have been operationalized under UDAN Scheme including 5 airports of UP, namely, Hindon, Bareilly, Prayagraj, Agra and Kanpur.
