GOVERNMENT LOANS TO DIARY UNITS IN KARNATAKA

1372. SHRI IRANNA KADADI:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government provides loans upto ₹6 lakhs for setting up small dairy units across the country including Karnataka;
- (b) if so, the details of total number of farmers provided loans for setting up small dairy units during the last three years, State-wise;
- (c) whether the said loan amount is very meagre for setting up a modern dairy units, if so, whether Government is considering to increase this amount; and
- (d) whether banks do not show much interest in giving away small and micro loans, if so, the details of the action likely to be taken by Government against such banks?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING
(SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

- (a) Under the erstwhile Central Sector Scheme - Dairy Entrepreneurship Development Scheme (DEDS) implemented across the country by the Department through National Bank of Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) during the period from 2010-11 to 2019-20, there was a provision for approval of loans upto ₹7 lakhs for setting up small dairy units..
- (b) The details of State-wise back ended subsidy disbursed by NABARD under DEDS during the last three years is at **Annexure**.
- (c) & (d) Does not arise as DEDS has already been discontinued from 2020-21.
