### SKILL DEVELOPMENT OF YOUTH

## Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether Government has prepared any action- plan for making the youth of the country skilled and preparing them in accordance with the demand of the labour market, particularly during the grave situation of COVID-19 and in order to provide job opportunities to them;
- (b) Whether Government has conducted any survey in this regard and if so, the details thereof: and
- (c) the number of institutions providing training in skill development functioning in various States, States-wise data thereof?

#### ANSWER

# MINISTER OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)

(a) In order to meet the challenges arising out of prolonged nationwide lockdown due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic which caused disruption in classroom and onsite training programmes, online blended training programmes were introduced in both short term and long term skilling, for all including the youth. Blended training programmes through Digital mode is crucial in the post Covid era to ensure skilling for the youth and also to address the requirements of Industrial Revolution 4.0. Such training programmes using on-line mode have further advantages such as increasing the reach of training, less commutation for trainees, particularly women trainees, etc.

Further, the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) under the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE), has created e-Skill India, a multi-lingual portal, for providing e-skilling opportunities to the Indian youth. e-Skill India works collaboratively as an e-Learning aggregator portal by establishing strategic digital skilling partnerships with knowledge partners to bring best-in-class digital opportunities for the Indian youth under one

roof. The portal has over 900 e-courses and more than 7.5 lakh enrolments. Majority of e-courses on e-Skill India are offered for free. Similarly, in the field of long term training, the Directorate General of Training under MSDE has launched Bharat Skill Portal covering 29 popular courses, e-learning video content for 71 courses and Question Bank for all the 137 trades under Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) for ITIs, benefitting 9,38,851 trainees. Further, during the Covid period, a scheme named Garib Kalyan Rojgar Abhiyaan(GKRA) was launched in June 2020 to address the impact of Covid on migrant workers in India. On the lines of GKRA, MSDE has undertaken demand-driven skilling / orientation for sustainable livelihood opportunities under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY). This program is being implemented across 119 districts of 6 States namely Assam, Bihar, Odisha, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh. The total number of migrant workers trained and assessed are 70,823 and 59,888 respectively as of 10th July 2021.

- (b) The Covid-19 pandemic forced temporary closure of many skill training centres and institutions. So, no such study could be taken up. Government is trying to ensure that these are again fully operational.
- (c) Details of number of institutions providing skill development training under Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) under various schemes viz; (i) Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) (ii) Jan Shikshan Sansthan(JSS) (iii) National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) (iv) Craftsman Training Scheme- [training through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs)] are given at **Annexure-I, Annexure-II**, **Annexure-III** and **Annexure-IV** respectively.
