MODERN BUS TERMINALS

784. SHRI DEEPAK PRAKASH:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government is considering to contribute a certain amount to the total cost of modern bus terminals to be set up by the States;
- (b) if so, whether any amount has been provided to State Government of Jharkhand so far; and
- (c) whether State Government of Jharkhand has recently sent any proposal or suggestion regarding modernising the bus terminal?

- (a) Ministry of Road Transport and Highways formulated a scheme ,namely, "Development of Bus Ports on BOT basis" for implementation during 12th Five year plan. This scheme provides for financial assistance for development of bus ports/terminals on BOT basis. The revised guidelines for development of Bus Ports in States/UTs on BOT/HAM basis were also issued in September 2018 for development of bus ports with support from the Central Government in the form of Viability Gap Fund (VGF).
