STATUS OF LINGUISTIC MINORITY COMMUNITIES

1558. SHRI SUJEET KUMAR:

Will the Minister of **MINORITY AFFAIRS** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of linguistic minority communities identified across the country, State-wise including Odisha; and
- (b) the details of sites/monuments preserved for said minority communities, State-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF MINORITY AFFAIRS (SHRI MUKHTAR ABBAS NAQVI)

(a) The Article 29 and 30 of the Constitution provide for protection of interest of minorities which includes Linguistic Minorities also. The working definition followed by the Commissioner for Linguistic Minorities is as follows:- "Linguistic Minorities are group or collectivities of individuals residing in the territory of India or any part thereof having a distinct language or script of their own. The language of the minority group need not be one of the twenty two languages mentioned in the Eighth Schedule of the Constitution. In other words, linguistic minorities at the State level mean any group or groups of people whose mother tongues are different from the principal language of the State, and at the district and taluka/tehsil levels, different from the principal language of the district or taluka/ tehsil concerned." The linguistic minorities are therefore identified by the respective States/ UTs.

The State/UT wise, broad linguistic profile is available in the 52nd Report of the Commissioner for Linguistic Minorities (CLM).

(b) There are 3693 monuments and sites, declared as of National importance throughout the country, which are protected, preserved and conserved by Archaeological Survey of India. However, the monuments/sites are not susceptible to such classification, based on linguistic minorities. The list of such monuments/sites is at Annexure.
