- (a) Whether it is a fact that the Comptroller and Auditor General (C&AG) has strongly criticized the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) for providing undue advantage to various concessionaires who failed to complete the road projects across the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof:

- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;

- (b) to (d) The Action Taken by NHAI on all the C&AG audit paras, duly vetted by C&AG, are submitted to the Lok Sabha Secretariat explaining the reasons for delay in completion of the projects, action taken to complete the projects, levying the applicable damages/termination of the contract and freezing the Escrow Account of the concessionaire, as per the merits of the case.
