Budget for National Sports Development Fund

1590 Shri Derek O' Brien:

Will the Minister of Youth Affairs and Sports be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the budgetary allocation for the National Sports Development Fund;
- (b) whether the budgetary allocation for the said fund has decreased in the last two years, if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the budgetary support for meritorious sportspersons has also been reduced in the last two years, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER FOR YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS [SHRI ANURAG SINGH THAKUR]

(a): The details of the budgetary allocation for the National Sports Development Fund (NSDF) for last two years is as under:

(b): NSDF receives matching contributions from the Central Government. Release of funds by the Central Government is based on Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) funds received during a year. Funds received from CSR and Central Government are credited to NSDF Corpus from where expenditure on approved projects/activities is incurred. This remains an ongoing process. As per practice, difference between total CSR funds received/expected and provided by the Government, is provisioned in the budget.

Allocation of Rs.50.00 crore for NSDF during 2020-21 was considered sufficient as Government matching share keeping in view the likelihood of contribution from donors during 2020-21. Since, only Rs.7.00 crore was received as CSR contribution to NSDF during January and February 2021, and as a matter of prudence, the provision was reduced to Rs.7.23 core in RE 2020-21.

(c): There are three schemes for meritorious sportspersons viz. Scheme of Cash Awards to Medal Winners in International Sports Events and their Coaches; Pension to Meritorious Sportspersons and Pandit Deendayal Upadhyay National Welfare Fund. The details of the budgetary support provided under these schemes during last two years i.e. 2019-20 and 2020-21 is as under:
