Reservation in allotment of dealerships of petroleum products

1876 Smt. Phulo Devi Netam:

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) have any reservation policy for Scheduled Castes (SCs), Scheduled Tribes (STs) and Other Backward Classes (OBCs) for allocation of 'Company Owned, Company Operated' (COCO) outlets;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the names of categories and percentage of reservation quota in dealerships/distributorships of petroleum products; and
- (d) the details of the procedure for draw of lots in the selection of dealers/distributorships of petroleum products?

(a)&(b) Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) have informed that there are two types of Company Owned & Company Operated (COCO) Outlets viz. Permanent COCO and Temporary COCO.

Permanent COCOs are directly operated by Public Sector OMCs, while in case of temporary COCOs, Public Sector OMCs divest these temporary COCOs to various eligible Letter of Intent Holders under SC/ST/Corpus Fund, based on their seniority and choice as per the guidelines issued by MoP&NG.

(c)&(d) The guidelines for selection of Retail Outlet (RO) dealerships/LPG distributorships have provisions of 22.5% reservation for SCs/STs and 27% reservation for OBCs in allotment of RO dealerships and LPG distributorships. The percentage of reservation for RO for various categories in all the States except Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Nagaland and Mizoram are as under:
