**CONNECTION OF PANCHAYAT HEADQUARTERS WITH OPTICAL FIBRE**

Will the Minister of Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) whether all the Panchayat Headquarters in the country have been connected with optical fibre cable;
- (b) if so, the details of their number, State-wise; and
- (c) if not, the number of remaining Gram Panchayats, State-wise?

**(a)** BharatNet project is being implemented in a phased manner to provide broadband connectivity to all Gram Panchayats (GPs) in the country through an optimal mix of media (Optical Fibre Cable/Radio/Satellite). As on 09.07.2021, a total number of 1,57,919 GPs have been made Service Ready, out of which 1,53,836 GPs are connected on Optical Fibre Cable (OFC) media in the country.

**(b) & (c)** The State/Union Territory (UT)-wise details of the Service Ready GPs on OFC, and the remaining GPs which are yet to be made Service Ready on OFC under BharatNet project in the country, are given in **Annexure**.
