REVAMPING OF BSNL/MTNL

1946 Shri G.C. Chandrashekhar:

Will the Minister of Communications be pleased to state:

(a) the loss or profit of MTNL & BSNL during the last three years, their total liabilities as compared to their profits, and the service infrastructure available with them in comparison to their private counterparts for mobile services;

(b) whether BSNL and MTNL have failed to attract customers as compared to their private counterparts despite having large infrastructure, particularly in urban areas;

(c) if so, the reasons found out by these Government companies including for call drops and low connectivity; and

(d) whether Government is considering the restructuring/revamping of these companies to make them competitive and profitable?

(b) & (c) BSNL and MTNL are dominant players in wireline segment however, they are facing intense competition in the mobile segment. Despite competitive market in mobile segment and the absence of 4G services (except in few places), BSNL continue to maintain its subscriber base. There is marginal decline in subscriber base of MTNL.

Details of subscriber market share of BSNL and MTNL in the mobile segment for the last five years are as under:

Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) monitors the performance of the TSPs including BSNL against the benchmark for various Quality of Service (QoS) parameters laid down by TRAI by way of QoS regulations issued from time to time, through Quarterly Performance Monitoring Reports (PMRs).

As per PMR for quarter ending December 2020, BSNL and MTNL are meeting all the QoS parameters for call drops fixed by TRAI for both Landline and Mobile subscribers in all the Circles except West Bengal Circle for BSNL.

(d) The Government approved a revival plan for BSNL/MTNL on 23.10.2019 which is under implementation. BSNL and MTNL have turned EBITDA +ve during 2020-21.
