(a) & (b): The task of designing and developing of a national document on National Professional Standards for Teachers (NPST) is being carried out by the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE).

The exercise of digital consultation was carried out for suggestions/inputs for overall coherence in preparing the document on NPST to ensure sustainable and positive change in the Teacher Education Sector. An extensive review of the inputs collected for NPST is done in accordance with the mandate of National Education Policy.
