#### Hiring retired teachers for teachers' training programmes

#### ANSWER

### MINISTER OF EDUCATION (SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)

(a) & (b): As per New Education Policy (NEP) para 15.11, "A National Mission for Mentoring shall be established, with a large pool of outstanding senior/retired faculty – including those with the ability to teach in Indian languages – who would be willing to provide short and long-term mentoring/professional support to university/college teachers."

Such mentoring exercise for schools, teacher education institutions has been entrusted to National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE).
