INCREASE IN THE RETAIL PRICE OF DAILY FOOD ITEMS

Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION be pleased to state:

- (a) the retail price of the foodgrain items in the present year, 2021 in comparison to 2015 and by how much the price value has been increased, especially important daily use food items like gehoon, chawal, cooking oil, tuar dal, moong dal and vegetables, spice like tamater, aalu, namak, haldi and aata etc; and
- (b) the reasons behind the hike of retail prices and the details of each item mentioned above?

(a) & (b): Monthly average retail prices of 22 essential food commodities for January, February, March, April, May, June and July in 2015 and 2021, and also the percentage increase in prices in 2021 over each of the corresponding months of 2015 are given at **Annexure**.

Prices of food items are inter-alia affected by mismatch in demand and supply, shortfall in production owing to adverse weather conditions, seasonality, increase in transportation costs, supply chain constraints like lack of storage facilities, artificial scarcity by hoarding and increase in international prices as in the case of edible oil.
