Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Central Government has urged various States to release land for airport projects during the last three years;
- (b) if so, the State-wise details thereof including Rajasthan;
- (c) the details of the land released by the States;
- (d) whether the Central Government has formulated any policy regarding land acquisition for building airports in the country; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons thereof?

- (a) to (c): The state-wise details of land requirements projected by the Airports Authority of India (AAI) to various State Governments/UTs for development of airports and the land handed over by the State Governments to AAI are enclosed as Annexure.
- (d) & (e): The Government of India has formulated the National Civil Aviation Policy-2016, which inter-alia provides that the land for the development of the airport is to be provided by the respective State Government free of cost and free from all encumbrances.
