#### HOUSING FOR POOR AND MARGINALISED

#### NO. 1821. SHRI RAKESH SINHA:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of houses constructed for poor and marginalised in urban areas during 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21, State-wise details thereof;
- (b) how much Government non-refundable grant is given for the construction to each beneficiary;
- (c) by when Government will fulfil its target of Housing for all; and
- (d) how much amount has been allocated and how much of that has been utilised for the construction of houses in these years?

#### ANSWER

## THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

(a): State/ Union Territory (UT)-wise details of total number of houses constructed for urban poor under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban (PMAY-U) during 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 are at Annexure.

(b): Central Government provides different levels of non-refundable financial assistance under following four verticals of the Scheme:

Further, States/UTs also provide different levels of financial assistance to the beneficiaries under ISSR, AHP and BLC verticals of the Scheme.

(c): Based on the project proposals submitted by the States/ UTs as per their assessed demand of houses under the Scheme, around 113 lakh houses have been sanctioned across the country. Against the total sanctioned houses, 84.40 lakh have been grounded for construction and over 50 lakh have beencompleted and delivered to the beneficiaries. The Scheme will be implemented up to 31.03.2022. States/ UTs have been advised to expedite the construction of sanctioned houses so that all houses are completed within thestipulated periodand the vision of 'Housing for All' can be achieved.

(d): Details of Central Assistancereleased and utilised during 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 for construction of houses under the Scheme are as under:
