SETTING UP OF TEXTILE PARKS

With a view to increase investments, generate employment opportunities and boost exports in textile sector, Ministry of Textiles has been implementing Scheme for Integrated Textile Park (SITP) to provide subsidy for setting up textile parks with world-class, state-of-the-art infrastructure in textile hubs across the country. The primary objective of the Scheme is to provide financial assistance to a group of entrepreneurs to establish state-of-the-art infrastructure facilities in a cluster for setting up their textile units. The scheme has been in operation from 01.04.2017 to 31.03.2020 and was extended upto 31.03.2021.

Under SITP, 66 parks were sanctioned. 24 have been completed as per scheme guidelines, 32 are operational and at various stages of implementation and 10 parks have been cancelled. So far, Rs 1,469 crores of GoI grant has been released, 1.02 lakh employment generated and Rs. 13,311 crore investments have been attracted.

The proposed scheme to launch seven mega investment textile parks , MITRAs is awaiting approval of the Cabinet.
