**CONSTRUCTION OF ROADS UNDER PMGSY IN GOA**

2220 SHRI VINAY DINU TENDULKAR:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of budget allocated for the construction of total length of roads and the details of the area in the year 2021-22 under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY);
- (b) the district-wise and road-wise details of the allocation made in 2021-22;
- (c) the details of the length of allocated road construction work;
- (d) the progress made towards road construction in Goa and the number of projects proposed; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

**ANSWER**

(a) A sum of Rs. 15,000 crore has been allocated for implementation of Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) in the country during the financial year 2021-22. A total of 61,703 Km road length is targeted for completion during 2021-22 as per the state/UT-wise details indicated in **Annexure-I**. The central share of funds for implementation of the scheme is released by the Ministry to the State Government/UT administration. Further release of funds to the programme implementation units (PIUs) at the district level is done by the respective state depending on the projects sanctioned to the district and their expenditure plan.

(b) & (c) A total 7,670.28 Km road length has been sanctioned under PMGSY during 2021-22 as per state/UT-wise details given below:-
