#### VACCINE ADMINISTRATION TO COMMUNITY BASED HEALTH WORKERS

#### 2488. SHRI BINOY VISWAM:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the data on vaccination coverage to all frontline community-based health workers (ASHAs and ANMs) across all States and UTs;
- (b) the data on reported incidents of violence against ASHAs while they have administered their COVID-19 duties, including vaccination drives;
- (c) the measures that are underway to prevent such instances of violence; and
- (d) how many training sessions have been designed for ASHAs on the preparation for the third wave of COVID?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (d) ASHAs and ANMs have been included under the priority group of Health Care Workers for COVID-19 Vaccination, as guided by National Expert Group on Vaccine Administration for COVID-19 (NEGVAC). COVID-19 vaccination coverage among Health Care Workers (as on 5<sup>th</sup> August 2021) is at Annexure I.

State /UTs have been advised to facilitate and encourage the role of ASHAs in Covid management duties. The Epidemic Disease (Amendment) Act 2020 provides for strict penalties against those who commit "acts of violence" against health care service personnel.

At National level, National Health Systems Resource Centre has conducted training of State and District trainers on Pediatric care in COVID-19. Total 2,750 State and District trainers were trained from all States and UTs (except Andaman and Nicobar). As on 5<sup>th</sup> August 2021, total 4,21,290 (43%) ASHA have been trained from States/UTs on Pediatric Care in COVID-19.
