**SPLITTING OF ORDNANCE FACTORY BOARD**

2259 SHRI SAMBHAJI CHHATRAPATI:

Will the Minister of Defence be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ordnance Factory Board with 41 manufacturing units which produce arms, ammunition and clothes for defence personnel has been split into seven corporate units;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the arms and ammunitions produced by Ordnance factories were of sub-standard resulting in accidents while using them in the field by defence personnel; and
- (d) if so, the reasons for the delay in taking such a decision much earlier and the mechanism now been worked out for the production of quality arms and ammunitions?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b): Yes, Sir. To enhance functional autonomy, efficiency and unleash new growth potential and innovation in Ordnance Factories, the Government of India has decided to convert the production units of Ordnance Factory Board into 07 Defence Public Sector Undertakings. The details are at Annexure.

(c) & (d): No, Sir. OFB manufactures arms and ammunition following laid down specifications, after drawing a Quality Assurance (QA) plan provided by the Authorities Holding Sealed Particulars (Directorate General of Quality Assurance/Defence Research & Development Organisation) and supplies the same to the users after due inspection by DGQA. In spite of the above, accidents/defects do occur at the User end in certain cases. Major incidences are investigated through defect investigation mechanism by DGQA and remedial actions are taken as per the recommendations.
