### SYSTEM FOR PENSION ADMINISTRATION RAKSHA

#### 2267 SMT. VANDANA CHAVAN:

Will the Minister of Defence be pleased to state:

(a) State/UT-wise number of beneficiaries of System for Pension Administration Raksha (SPARSH) envisaged;

(b) whether data of serving personnel and pensioners hosted on SPARSH are susceptible to data leakage;

(c) if so, details thereof and steps being taken to prevent this;

(d) the details of steps being taken by Government to facilitate utilization of SPARSH by pensioners who are old, disabled or living in remote areas without access to internet who cannot avail of online pension schemes;

(e) whether Government plans to allow banks to continue functioning as grievance redressal mechanisms; and

(f) if so, the details thereof and if not, reasons therefor?

# ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE SHRI AJAY BHATT

(a) The state wise number of beneficiaries currently using SPARSH as on date is attached as Annexure.

(b) & (c): No, Sir. SPARSH hosts all requisite security features. The system has also been security certified by an independent third-party auditor and Ministry of Defence-designated cyber-security agency.

(d) Service Centres have been set up to ensure access for old age, disabled pensioners, those living in remote areas or those who are unable to avail online access for any reason.

(e) & (f): Yes, Sir. Banks also function as Service Centres where pensioners can register their grievances or monitor their disposal. An agreement has been signed with State Bank of India and Punjab National Bank in this regard.
