(a) & (b) The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment had been implementing a "Central Sector Scheme of Prevention of Alcoholism and Substance (Drug) Abuse" till Financial year 2019-20 after which this scheme has been merged into National Action Plan for Drug Demand Reduction (NAPDDR) with effect from 01.04.2020.

Total number of beneficiaries during the financial year 2020-21 under NAPDDR are 2,08,415 persons .
