**BUILDING A TERMINAL AT HARDINGE PARK**

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government working on any scheme to build a terminal for passenger trains on the land of Hardinge Park in Patna, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the land required for this, the land acquired till date, the land to be acquired and from whom; and
- (c) the cost of the terminal and by when it will be ready?

(a) Yes, Sir.

(b) & (c) Total land required is 7.3 Acre and land acquired till date is 'Nil'. The proposed cost of the terminal is ₹97,28,50,000/-. For construction to begin, land has to be handed over to Railway Administration by State Government of Bihar. Till such time land is not handed over to Railway Administration by State Government of Bihar, it is not possible to give any timeline for completion of the project.
