- (a) the institute-wise details of the vacant teaching and non-teaching positions in Central Universities, IITs and IIMs;
- (b) the status of the vacant positions belonging to SC, ST, OBC and EWS categories in the said institutes;
- (c) whether the provisions of reservation have been relaxed in IITs and IIMs; and
- (d) by when Government plans to fill these vacancies by running a campaign?

(a) The total number of vacant teaching & non-teaching posts in Central Universities, IITs and IIMs are as below:-

(b) to (d) Occurrence of vacancies and filling up of posts is a continuous process and Institutions publish rolling/need based advertisements to fill the vacant position following the due process. Ministry of Education time to time instructed to institutions to follow the provisions of reservation to fill the vacancies, including the vacancies of SC/ST/OBC/EWS. All Higher Educational Institutions functioning under the administrative control of the Ministry of Education have been instructed to fill faculty positions that are lying vacant especially in the SC/ST/OBC/EWS category in their institutions, by way of a special drive and in a Mission Mode manner within a period of one year starting from 5th September, 2021 to 4th September, 2022.
