## RAJYA SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO.1141 TO BE ANSWERED ON 08.12.2021

#### **Enrolment of students in schools**

#### 1141 Dr. K. Keshava Rao:

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) the percentage of enrolment of students in schools under the Central Government from classes I to XII for the years 2019, 2020 and 2021;
- (b) whether the Central Government plans to provide additional chances under the Right to Education (RTE) Act to those students who could not enroll in schools on account of the COVID-19 pandemic and have exceeded the permissible age;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

#### **ANSWER**

### MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SMT. ANNPURNA DEVI)

- (a): The Department of School Education and Literacy (DoSEL), Ministry of Education has developed the Unified District Information System for Education Plus (UDISE+) system to record data on indicators of school education provided by all the States and Union Territories. As per Unified District Information System for Education Plus (UDISE+), Enrolment of students from class I to class XII for the year 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20 are at annexure.
- (b) to (d): The Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, 2009, mandates the appropriate Government to provide free and compulsory elementary education to every child of the age 6 to 14 years in a neighbourhood school. Under the Right to Education (RTE) Act where a child above six years of age has not been admitted in any school or though admitted, could not complete his or her elementary education, then, he or she shall be admitted in class appropriate to his or her age.
