Central Educational Institutions in Andhra Pradesh

1152 Shri Y. S. Chowdary:

Will the Minister of **EDUCATION** be pleased to state:

- (a) the status of Central Educational Institutions established in Andhra Pradesh after bifurcation;
- (b) the number of annual intake of students in these institutions during the last three years;
- (c) whether the sanctioned posts in the various faculties have been filled up;
- (d) if not, the number of posts which are lying vacant;
- (e) whether any alternative arrangement has been made to fill the teaching faculty like visiting/ on deputation/guest teachers, if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) by when all the vacant posts are expected to be filled by regular incumbents?

(a) The present status of 7 Central Educational Institutions established by Ministry of Education under Andhra Pradesh Re-organisation Act, 2014 in the State of Andhra Pradesh is as under:

| 1 | Indian Institute of Technology, Tirupati | The academic session of IIT-Tirupati started in a temporary campus in 2015. The construction work for permanent campus has been divided into three stages, namely, 1A, 1B & 1C. Stage 1A and 1B of permanent campus has been completed and Stage 1C is under construction. |
| 2 | Indian Institute of Management, Vishakhapatnam | The academic session of IIM Vishakhapatnam started in a temporary campus in 2015. 20% of Construction work of permanent campus at Village Gambheeram, Visakhapatnam has been completed. |
| 3 | National Institute of Technology, Tadepalligudem | The academic session of NIT Tadepalligudem started in a temporary campus in 2015. Now, the institute is functioning from its permanent campus in the year 2020. |

| 4 | Indian Institute of Science Education and Research, Tirupati | The Indian Institute of Science Education and Research, Tirupati commenced its operation from the transit campus in the year 2015. The work for permanent campus at Yerpedu is under construction. |
| 5 | Indian Institute of Information Technology Design and Manufacturing, Kurnool | Indian Institute of Information Technology Design and Manufacturing, Kurnool started functioning from its temporary campus Kancheepuram in 2015. The institute has started functioning from its permanent campus at Kurnool in the year 2018. |
| 6 | Central University, Ananthapur | The academic session of the University started from the temporary campus at Jawaharlal Nehru Technical University (JNTU), Anantapur from the academic year 2018-19. The DPR has been approved. |
| 7 | Tribal University, Vizianagaram | The academic session of the University started from the year 2019-20 in the academic building of the erstwhile PG Centre building of Andhra University at Kondakarakam Village, Cantonment, Vizianagaram. The report dated 29.09.2021 of the Site Selection Committee for establishment of the University in Vizianagaram District has been submitted. |

The vacancies keep arising due to retirement, resignation and additional requirements on account of enhancement of students' strength. The institutions are adopting various measures to address faculty shortages in order to ensure that studies of students are not affected which inter-alia, includes hiring through contract, reemployment or through visiting faculty.
