**ROADS CONSTRUCTED IN BIHAR UNDER BHARATMALA PROJECT**

1203. SHRI RAM NATH THAKUR:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the roads being constructed in Bihar under the Bharatmala project;
- (b) the complete details thereof;
- (c) the present status of the expressway planned to be constructed from Patna to Kolkata as proposed under Bharatmala project; and
- (d) the details of various phases of construction of projects to be launched in Bihar under the Bharatmala project and the plan to complete those projects?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (d) Projects of 992 km length have been planned in the State of Bihar under Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase-I. 12 projects having length of 612 km costing of Rs. 13,720 crore have been awarded and same are in different phases of implementation. The projects are given a time period of 2/3 years for completion depending upon the size and complexity. There is no direct expressway envisaged in Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase-I for connecting Patna to Kolkata.
