#### FUNDS FOR SC/ST WORKERS UNDER MGNREGA

#### 1224 DR. V. SIVADASAN:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is aware that the funds for the SC/ST MGNREGA workers are not received regularly;
- (b) if so, the action taken to solve this issue; and
- (c) the amount of the funds yet to be delivered to the States in this regard, State-wise?

#### ANSWER

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a) & (b): Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS) is a demand driven wage employment programme and funds are released to the States/UTs on the basis of "agreed to" Labour Budget (LB) and performance of the States/UTs during the financial year. Fund release to States/UTs is a continuous process and Central Government is committed in making funds available keeping in view the demand for work on the ground.

The category wise (SC, ST and Others) wage payment system, as made applicable from this current financial year, has been introduced to accurately reflect on ground flow of funds to various population groups. Its further streamlining is being undertaken.

As per the provision of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, the beneficiaries are entitled to get wage payment within 15 days of closure of Muster Roll of the work. Government of India has also issued a detailed Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) to the States/UTs to ensure timely wage payment.
