# 1299 SHRI JAWHAR SIRCAR:

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the present building of the National Museum is sought to be demolished and if so, by when;
- (b) whether its entire collection has been photographed, carefully documented or digitally recorded so as to prevent damage, loss or switching of genuine artefacts during, before or after their movement; and
- (c) whether the proposed sites to which these items may be shifted are certified to be suitable for a museum by concerned agencies, the details thereof?

(a) to (c): No decision regarding demolition of National Museum has been taken. Digitization of the objects is a continuous process and out of 2,06,169 number of objects of the National Museum, 80,997 are photo documented, digitally recorded.
