- (a) the details of all leased/rental lands/runways/fields of Airports Authority of India (AAI);
- (b) the reasons for some of the major metro cities like Pune not having a civilian airport and are still relying on leased runways;
- (c) whether Government has conducted studies/research to analyze the impact on tourism, trade and industry due to not having good air connectivity; and (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a): The details of all leased/ rental lands/ runways/ fields of Airports Authority of India are at Annexure.
- (b): Airports Authority of India utilizes the defence airports for civil operations in many cities across the country. However, the projects for development of new airports in these cities are considered depending on the receipt of proposal from the respective State Government, commercial viability, traffic demand, availability of land etc.
- (c) & (d): While air connectivity surely has a favorable impact on the economy in general, no specific study has been conducted by this Ministry on the impact on tourism, trade and industry due to lack of good air connectivity.
