AUTOMATING THE ECHS INFRASTRUCTURE

Will the Minister of **Defence** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any action has been taken to automate the entire ECHS infrastructure and bring it online which will reduce paper work, repeated referrals and footfall in the ECHS facilities;
- (b) whether any private enterprise/industry have been co-opted for supporting ECHS facilities or for sponsoring the construction of ECHS hospitals under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiatives;
- (c) whether, DRDO has developed a hospital at Secunderabad in co-ordination with Apollo group; and
- (d) whether Government is planning to do the same for armed forces also, especially in metros like Delhi, Mumbai and Pune?

- (a) Presently, the automation in Ex-servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS) has been carried out independently in:
 - (i) Beneficiary enrolment
 - (ii) Functioning of Polyclinics
 - (iii) Paperless processing of bills by Bill Processing Agency (BPA)

The above processes have evolved independently and are not integrated.

- (b) No private enterprise/industry has been co-opted for sponsoring construction of ECHS facilities under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) presently.
- (c) & (d): No such hospital in co-ordination with Apollo Group is being developed by Government presently.
