NO. 1666. SHRI M. MOHAMED ABDULLA:

Will the Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs be pleased to state:

- (a) the steps taken to alleviate homelessness in the country;
- (b) the number of homeless persons in the country, State-wise;
- (c) the list of schemes introduced for low cost housing in the country and the details thereof; and
- (d) the amount of funds allocated, disbursed and utilised for low cost housing schemes, State-wise?

ANSWER

(a): 'Land' and 'Colonization' are State subjects and therefore, it is the responsibility of the State/ Union Territory (UT) Governments to implement housing schemes to provide houses to their citizens. However, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs supplements the efforts of State/ UT Governments in providing houses to all eligible households in urban areas through its housing schemes.

(b): As per census 2011, the number of houseless people was 17,73,040 in India which includes 9,38,348 from urban areas and 8,34,692 from rural areas. State/ UT-wise details are at Annexure-I.

(c): The Ministry is implementing Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban (PMAY-U) since 25.06.2015 for giving Central assistance to States/ UTs for providing all-weather pucca houses to all eligible urban households. The Scheme addresses affordable housing requirement in urban areas through four verticals: (i) "In-Situ" Slum Redevelopment (ISSR) (ii) Credit-Linked Subsidy Scheme (CLSS) (iii) Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP) and (iv) Beneficiary-led individual house construction or enhancement (BLC).

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Earlier, Government of India had implemented Basic Services to the Urban Poor (BSUP) and Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme (IHSDP) components of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) for assisting State/ UT Governments in providing housing and basic services to urban poor/ slum dwellers. The duration of Mission was seven years from 2005-06 to March, 2012 which was extended up to March, 2017 for completion of projects sanctioned under JNNURM till March, 2012. The Government also implemented Rajiv Awas Yojana (RAY) for providing houses along with basic civic and social infrastructure for slum dwellers and urban poor. RAY has been subsumed in the PMAY-U.

(d): State/ UT-wise details of Central assistance approved, released and utilised under PMAY-U, RAY and JNNURM are at Annexures-II, III and IV respectively.
