TARGETS ACHIEVED UNDER HOUSING FOR ALL PROGRAMME

NO. 1681. SHRI VIJAY PAL SINGH TOMAR: SHRI HARNATH SINGH YADAV:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of targets achieved under Housing for All programme under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban (PMAY-U) so far, State-wise;
- (b) whether the said programme is on track to achieve its targeted goal by 2024;
- (c) the roadmap of Government to achieve above mentioned targets; and
- (d) whether Government has any specific scheme for making urban areas of the country slum free, if so, the details thereof and, if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

- (a) to (c): Yes, Sir. Against the validated demand of 1.12 crore houses received from States/ UTs based on the demand survey conducted by them as per the eligibility criteria of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban (PMAY-U), 1.14 crore houses have been sanctioned by the Ministry. Out of this, nearly 90 lakh houses have been grounded and nearly 53 lakh have been completed and delivered to the eligible beneficiaries, so far. State/ UT-wise achievement is at Annexure. Construction of houses under different verticals of the scheme are in full swing. The States/ UTs have been advised to expedite the construction of remaining sanctioned houses so that these houses are completed within the Mission period. Therefore, the implementation of PMAY-U is on track to complete the sanctioned houses within the stipulated period.
- (d): Land and Colonisation are State subjects. However, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs is supplementing the efforts of States/ UTs by providing central assistance under PMAY-U for construction of houses for all eligible families/ beneficiaries including slum dwellers. The "In-situ Slum Redevelopment (ISSR)" component under PMAY-U Mission mandates use of land as a resource for providing houses to slum dwellers across the country. So far, a total of 6.34 lakh houses for slums dwellers have been grounded, of which 4.55 lakh houses have been completed with basic facilities under the scheme.
