ESTABLISHMENT OF MSMEs IN RAJASTHAN

1705. DR. KIRODI LAL MEENA:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government proposes to establish and promote Micro, Small and Medium scale Enterprises in Dausa-Sawai Madhopur, Tonk and Karauli Dholpur Parliamentary Constituency in view of the large scale migration due to lack of any employment opportunities from districts of Dausa, Sawai Madhopur, Karauli and Alwar; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and, the steps taken by Government, in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI NARAYAN RANE)

(a) & (b): Promotion and development of enterprises is a State subject. The Central Government supplements the efforts of the State/UT Governments through various schemes, programmes and policy initiatives for promotion, development and enhancing the competitiveness of MSMEs in the country. The MSME sector consists of private players and the investments in this sector are made by the entrepreneurs themselves.

A number of schemes are being implemented by Ministry of MSME for MSMEs, including Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Credit Linked Capital Subsidy for Technology Upgradation Scheme (CLCS-TUS), Schemes for Khadi & Village Industries and Coir, International Cooperation Scheme, Procurement and Marketing Support Scheme, Scheme for Credit Guarantee Fund for Micro and Small Enterprises, National SC/ST Hub etc. Benefits under these schemes are available to all eligible MSMEs.
