## RAJYA SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION No. 1706 TO BE ANSWERED ON 13.12.2021

#### LOSS OF JOBS DUE TO COVID-19 PANDEMIC

1706. SHRI NEERAJ DANGI:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in the country, sector-wise, and State-wise;
- (b) the total number of jobs lost in MSMEs sector due to the COVID-19 pandemic;
- (c) the number of MSMEs which have availed loans under the emergency provisions announced by Government as part of the Aatmanirbhar Bharat package;
- (d) the details of funds sanctioned, under the Aatmanirbhar Bharat package, sector-wise; and
- (e) whether Government plans to extend the moratorium given by RBI to enterprises in MSMEs sector on repayment of loans?

#### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI NARAYAN RANE)

- (a): As per 73rd Round of NSS Report on Unincorporated Non-Agricultural Enterprises' (July 2015- June 2016) conducted by Ministry of Statistics & PI (MoSPI), the estimated number of MSMEs in All India was about 6.34 crore. The State/Union Territory—wise numbers of MSMEs are given at Annexure.
- (b): COVID-19 epidemic has temporarily affected various sectors including Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises in the country including their employment. As MSMEs are present in both formal and informal sector, data regarding temporary or permanent loss of jobs in MSME sector are not maintained by the Government of India in Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME).
- (c) & (d): Under Aatma Nirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan Government has taken a number of initiatives to support the MSME sector in the country. Some of them are:
  - i. Rs 20,000 crore Subordinate Debt for MSMEs.
  - ii. Rs 3 lakh crores Collateral free Automatic Loans for business, including MSMEs (existing overall guarantee limit under ECGLS has been enhanced from Rs. 3 lakh crore to Rs. 4.5 lakh crore).
  - iii. Rs. 50,000 crore equity infusion through MSME Fund of Funds.
  - iv. New revised criteria for classification of MSMEs.
  - v. New Registration of MSMEs through 'Udyam Registration' for Ease of Doing Business.
  - vi. No global tenders for procurement up to Rs. 200 crores, this will help MSME.
  - vii. As informed by the NCGTC, under ECLGS an amount of Rs. 2.82 lakh crore have been sanctioned till 12.11.2021 out of which final guarantees worth Rs. 2.62 lakh crore have been issued so far to MLIs benefitting around 1.15 crore borrowers. A brief performance of ECLGS as on 12.11.2021 is an under:

(e): The Reserve Bank of India (RBI), vide circulars dated 27.03.2020 and 23.05.2020 on COVID-19 Regulatory package, permitted all lending institutions including commercial banks to grant a moratorium of six months on payments of all installments including EMIs falling due between 01.03.2020 and 31.08.2020, in respect of all term loans outstanding as on 01.03.2020. The said circulars do not lay down any conditions or criteria in respect of income of the individuals for availing of moratorium.
