**MUDRA Yojana beneficiaries**

1824. MS. SAROJ PANDEY:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the number of beneficiaries who have been benefitted by MUDRA Yojana run by the Government till date, State-wise; and
- (b) the total amount of funds released to these beneficiaries to grow their business and major occupations for which the funds have been released?

(a) to (b) Under the Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY), institutional credit up to Rs. 10 lakh is provided by Member Lending Institutions (MLIs) to micro/small business units for income generating activities in manufacturing, trading, services sectors and also for activities allied to agriculture.

As per data uploaded by Member Lending Institutions (MLIs) on Mudra portal, as on 26.11.2021, over 32.11 crore loans involving a disbursement of Rs. 16.50 lakh crore have been extended under PMMY, since its inception. The State/UT-wise details of number of accounts and disbursed amount under the Scheme is Annexed.
