Collection of GST in certain States

1825 # Ms. Saroj Pandey:

Will the Minister of **FINANCE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the amount of GST collected in Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and Odisha during the last three years, along with the ratio of Centre and State in the same;
- (b) whether the States have been provided their proportion of funds of the same; and
- (c) if so, the amount of the same and, if not, the quantum of funds of States pending with Government and by when it would be released?

ANSWER

(a): The amount of GST collected from domestic supply of Goods and Services in the State of Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and Odisha during the last three years along with the ratio of Centre and State is given as per **Annexure**.

(b) & (c): GST collection consists of CGST, SGST or IGST depending upon intra-state or inter-state supply of Goods or Services or both. CGST is credited to Consolidated Fund of India (CFI) while SGST is credited to the Consolidated Fund of respective States, whereas inter-state supply of goods or services or both is concerned, IGST is being levied and collected by the Centre. The IGST (Domestic + Imports) so collected has been apportioned / settled between the Union and the States/UTs on monthly basis, on the basis of place of consumption and cross utilization as envisaged under Goods and Services Tax Settlement of Funds Rules, 2017. Depending upon the amount of IGST remaining un-apportioned, provisional/advance settlement is being done from time to time on ad-hoc basis between Centre and States/UTs in the ratio of 50:50 and among the States on the basis of monthly revenue to be protected during that Financial Year.
