Campuses of new IITs

1954. Shri Kapil Sibal:

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that despite more than seven years since their establishment, the six new IITs are still operating from hired/temporary buildings;
- (b) whether it is also a fact that IIT Goa has not yet been provided land by the State Government; and
- (c) whether the lack of campus and academic infrastructure has curtailed the research and academic development of these institutes, if so, the steps which have been taken by Government to address the issue?

ANSWER

(a): The IITs at Tirupati, Palakkad, Jammu, Bhilai, Dharwad and Goa are fully functional. Presently, IIT Jammu, IIT Tirupati and IIT Palakkad are majorly functional from their transit campuses on the permanent campus sites, while IIT Dharwad, IIT Bhilai and IIT Goa are functioning from their temporary campuses. The construction of permanent campuses of these IITs, except IIT Goa, has commenced after the land parcels have been transferred by the State Governments to these IITs.

(b): Yes, Sir.

(c): The academic and research activities are not hindered in these IITs as they are fully functional.
