- (a) whether the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) has taken any action regarding heroin seized in Mundra Port in Gujarat;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reason therefor; and
- (c) the total number of cases registered under the Prevention of Illicit Traffic in Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (PITNDPS) Act during the last three years, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) had seized 2988.1 Kgs of Narcotics Substance (Heroin) between 17.09.2021 and 19.09.2021 at T.G. Terminal Private Limited Container Freight Station, Mundra Port, Gujarat. National Investigation Agency (NIA) has taken up investigation of the aforesaid case vide RC-26/2021/NIA/DLI dated 6/10/2021.
