PROJECTS UNDER SETU BHARATAM SCHEME

2013 SHRI M. MOHAMED ABDULLA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the list of Road Over Bridges proposed to be built under Setu Bharatam scheme, State-wise;
- (b) the amount of funds allocated, disbursed and utilised for the same, State-wise; and
- (c) the list of Road Over Bridges allocated to Pudukkottai district in Tamil Nadu and the details thereof?

- (a) The Statewise list of Road Over Bridges to be built under Setu Bharatam Programme is enclosed as Annexure-I.
- (b) Road Over Bridges are sometimes constructed as standalone projects and sometimes as part of improvement project for a section of National Highway. Hence, funds are not separately allocated nor expenditure/funds utilization separately maintained for construction of RoBs under Setu Bharatam programme.
- (c) No Road Over Bridge under Setu Bharatam Programme has been taken up in Pudukkottai district in Tamilnadu. However, one ROB in lieu of LC No.351 at Km 22/020 of NH-336 between Kumaramangalam and Keeranur Railway Stations in Pudukkottai District in Tamil Nadu was taken up by NHAI as part of the project of 2-lane with Paved Shoulders of Trichy Karaikudi section of NH-210 and completed in March, 2021.
