CONVERSION OF TWO LANE NAMAKKAL-TRICHY STATE HIGHWAY TO FOUR LANE

2025. SHRI K.R.N. RAJESHKUMAR:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the conversion of two lane into four lane project is being carried out on Namakkal–Trichy State highway in Tamil Nadu as this highway is having heavy traffic movement;
- (b) the estimated cost and the current status of this project;
- (c) whether it is a fact that the works are being done on only 26 kms out of 90 kms;
- (d) whether Government has any plans to develop the complete stretch of 90 kms; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (e) This Ministry is primarily responsible for the development and maintenance of National Highways in the country. Earlier, Trichy–Namakkal Stretch was a State Highway, out of which stretch from Musiri to Namakkal (61.96 km) was declared as National Highway no. 381B. Detailed Project Report (DPR) has been initiated for development of Musiri to Namakkal Stretch for finalizing alignment, cost and other project features etc.
