- (a) the details of the schemes being implemented by Government for skill development of the youth in States during the last one year, including Assam;
- (b) the details of funds allocated and released by Government to the States, including Assam, during last one year, State-wise, scheme-wise and agency-wise;
- (c) whether any new proposal has been sent to the Central Government by Government of Assam during the last one year; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by Government thereon?

(a) The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship is implementing the following skill development schemes for skill development of the youth across the country including Assam:

<b>S.No.</b>	<b>Schemes</b>	<b>Objective</b>
1	Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY)	Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is implementing its flagship scheme Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), with the objective to train candidates across India. PMKVY has two training components, namely, Short Term Training (STT) and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL).
2	Jan Shikshan Sansthan(JS	The scheme aims to provide vocational skills to non-literate, neo-literates, persons with rudimentary level of education up to

	S) Scheme	8th and school dropouts up to 12th standard in the age group of 15-45 years. The priority groups are women, SC, ST, minorities, divyangjan and other backward sections of the society. The Jan Shikshan Sansthan work at the doorstep of the beneficiaries with minimum infrastructure and resources. Under the scheme grant is released to Jan Shikshan Sansthan (NGOs) for Skill Development. More than 50% of JSS beneficiaries are from rural areas and it has many number of skill training programme in agriculture and related areas.
3	National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS)	This Scheme is for promoting apprenticeship training and increasing the engagement of apprentices by providing financial support to industrial establishments undertaking apprenticeship program under The Apprentices Act, 1961.
4	Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS)	This scheme is for providing long-term training in 143 trades through 14,711 Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) across the country. ITIs are run under the CTS.

Directorate General of Training (DGT) under MSDE is implementing World Bank assisted project Skills Strengthening for Industrial Value Enhancement (STRIVE) on pan India basis including Assam. The objective of the project is to improve relevance and efficiency of skills development provided through ITIs and apprenticeship. Various other schemes implemented in different states of the country including Assam are as under:

- i) Upgradation of existing Government ITIs into Model ITIs.
- ii) Enhancing Skill Development Infrastructure in NE States.

The details of coverage under these scheme are given at **Annexure-I**.

(b) The details of funds allocated and released by Government to the States, including Assam, during last one year, State-wise under schemes viz. PMKVY, JSS, NAPS and CTS are at **Annexure-II**, **Annexure-III**, **Annexure-IV** and **Annexure-V** respectively.

(c) No specific proposal has been sent to the Central Government by Government of Assam during the last one year. Application of ITIs etc. is a continuous and routine process.

(d) Does not arise in view of part (c) above.
