PROPOSAL TO SET UP PHCS IN BACKWARD VILLAGES

2640. DR. KIRODI LAL MEENA:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government proposes to set up Primary Health Centres (PHCs) in all the villages of the country particularly in backward villages;
- (b) if so, the number of such villages where there is no PHC till date, State-wise including Rajasthan; and
- (c) the funds allocated by the Central Government to set up new PHCs during each of the last three years and current year till date, State-wise?

(a) to (c):

Under the National Health Mission (NHM), Primary Health Centre (PHC) are established to cover a population of 30,000 in rural areas and 20,000 in hilly, tribal and desert areas.

As per the Rural Health Statistics 2019-20, as on 31.03.2020, a total of 24,918 rural PHCs and 5,895 urban PHCs have been functional in the country. State-wise details including for Rajasthan are given in Annexure-I.

State-wise details of State Program Implementation Plan approvals for the Primary Health Centres under NHM for the year 2018-19 to 2020-21 and current year 2021-22 are given at Annexure-II.
