## **National Highways Through Jharkhand**

2031. SHRI S. S. AHLUWALIA: Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) which are the national highways passing through Jharkhand State with details thereof:
- (b) whether they have been developed to national highways standards; and
- (c) if not, what steps Government propose to take to develop these highways?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (MAJ. GEN. (RETD.) B.C. KHANDURI): (a) National Highways No. 2, 6, 23, 31, 32, 33, Extn. of 75, 78, 80, 98, 99 and 100 are passing through Jharkhand State. Details are given in the Statement, (see below)

- (b) Our efforts are to maintain the National Highways to National Highway Standards. However newly declared National Highways need to be upgraded.
- (c) The Development and maintenance of the National Highways is a continuous process. National Highways are developed to the National Highway Standards depending upon the availability of funds.
