FM RADIO STATIONS IN COUNTRY

555. SHRI IRANNA KADADI

Will the Minister of **INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING** be pleased to state:

- (a) the FM Radio stations operational in the country, State-wise details thereof;
- (b) whether Government has taken any steps/proposes to take any steps to set up FM radio facility in the district headquarters including Belgaum under Belgaum Parliamentary Constituency in Karnataka and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether Government is earning revenue from FM radio stations and if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (d) the average estimated cost of setting up a FM radio station; and
- (e) whether Government has sanctioned new FM radio channels for farmers and fishermen and if so, the details thereof, State-wise?

ANSWER

- (a) Presently, 384 Private FM Radio channels are operational in 112 cities, spread across 26 States and 5 Union Territories. In addition, Prasar Bharati is having 523 FM transmitters located at 483 All India Radio (AIR) stations across the country. The state-wise details of AIR and private FM stations are at Annexure-I.
- (b) The Policy Guidelines on Expansion of FM radio broadcasting service through private agencies (Phase-III) provides for setting up of FM radio stations by Indian companies on city centric basis. Under FM Radio Phase-III, 4 channels have been approved for Belgaum, Karnataka. Prasar Bharati has approved setting up 4 nos. of 100 Watts FM transmitters in Karnataka.
- (c) The details of revenue earned by Government through Private FM Radio stations in the form of annual fee, state-wise, are at Annexure II.
- (d) Prasar Bharati is having AIR FM transmitters in the range of 100 Watts to 20 kW power. The average estimated cost of a typical 10 kW FM Station with 100 meter high tower is Rs. 15.00 crore.
- (e) Prasar Bharati is not having dedicated FM radio channels for farmers and fishermen. However, AIR stations broadcast programmes to cater to the needs of farmers and fishermen from time to time on their channels.
