Contingency plan for natural gas infrastructure

155. Shri Derek O' Brien:

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has a contingency plan towards a possible under-utilisation of gas-based infrastructure considering the increasing prices of LNG in Asia;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and, if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether Government plans on building other alternative cost effective transitions considering the high cost of gas-based technologies; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and, if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

- (a)& (b) Considering the demand of natural gas across sectors and the possibility of price of LNG coming down in future, high under-utilization of natural gas infrastructure is not expected.
- (c) & (d) Following steps have been taken by government for building other alternative cost effective transitions:
 - i. Sustainable Alternative Towards Affordable Transportation (SATAT) initiative has been initiated to promote Bio-CNG to complement usage of natural gas.
 - ii. Hydrogen Mission wherein the focus is on greater use of hydrogen in the energy mix.
