SUPER SPECIALITY HOSPITALS IN BIHAR UNDER PM SWASTHYA SURAKSHA YOJANA

240. SHRI SUSHIL KUMAR MODI:

Will the **MINISTER OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the super speciality hospitals equipped with 210 beds each are proposed to be built in medical colleges and hospitals located in Darbhanga and Muzaffarpur under Phase-3 of Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) and in Gaya, Bhagalpur and Patna under Phase-4 of the scheme respectively;
- (b) the cost value of each super speciality hospital among the five hospitals to be set up under Phase-3 and Phase-4 of the scheme, and the expenditure incurred on each hospital till date, with the physical progress thereof;
- (c) by when all these super speciality hospitals were supposed to be ready; and
- (d) the reasons for delay in completion of their construction and by when it will be completed?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (d): Government has approved upgradation of Government Medical Colleges (GMCs) at Darbhanga and Muzaffarpur under Phase-III and at Gaya, Bhagalpur and Patna under Phase –IV of the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY).

Details of approved cost, fund released, number of super specialty beds, physical progress, original and revised dates of completion are as under:-

The reasons for delay in completion of construction of Super Specialty Block (SSB) at GMC, Darbhanga are delay by State Government in demolition of existing buildings and removal of underground pipeline as well as flooding of site due to heavy rain, modification in structural drawings. The completion of SSB at SKMC, Muzaffarpur is delayed due to flooding of site during rainy season, modification in plan and slow progress of construction works by the contractor. Delay in non availability of sites for construction of SSB at GMC, Gaya and PMCH, Patna adversely affected progress of work at these GMCs whereas in respect of SSB at GMC, Bhagalpur, the delay in construction is due to delay in receipt of statutory approvals and water logging at the site during monsoon. During first and second waves of COVID 19 pandemic, supply of labour and material was adversely affected, which caused further delay in progress of SSBs at the above Medical Colleges.
