DATA ON PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES VACCINATED AND DECEASED DUE TO COVID-19

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the data on the number of People with Disabilities vaccinated for the 1st dose of COVID-19 and both the doses of COVID-19 available;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the data on the number of People with Disabilities deceased due to COVID-19 available;
- (e) if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (f) Government of India has been providing free supply of Covid vaccines in enough quantity to States/UTs for administration to adult population aged 18 years and above.

As on 28th November 2021, as per CoWIN portal, 8,390 People with Disabilities received first dose of COVID-19 and 4,018 received both doses of COVID-19 vaccine.

Total deaths due to Covid-19 (including People with Disabilities) as reported by States/UTs as on 27th November 2021 is 4,67,933.
