- (c) the data of the number of students from regional language schools who appeared for the CUCET since its inception?

(a) to (c): National Testing Agency (NTA) has informed that at present the Central University Common Entrance Test (CUCET) is being conducted for 12 Central Universities established under the Central Universities Act, 2009. For admission in Under Graduate (UG) Programmes, students from all the regional language schools are eligible to appear. As the NTA has conducted CUCET in 2021 for the first time, data was not collected.
