UAPA CASES

352. DR. V. SIVADASAN:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of people who got arrested under UAPA (Unlawful Activities Prevention Act.) during last five years;

(b) how many of the arrested got punished;

(c) in how many cases the court revoked the UAPA, during last five years;

(d) in how many cases the accused have been in jail for a period of more than one year, the details thereof based on what period they have been in jail; and

(e) how many people are currently in jail or custody under UAPA, the details of the punished and the cases under investigation, based on what period they have been in?

(a) to (c): The National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) compiles the data on crime as reported to it by the States and Union Territories and publishes the same in its annual publication 'Crime in India'. The latest published report is of the year 2020. As per the Report, the number of persons arrested (PAR), persons convicted (PCV), the number of cases abated (CABC), cases quashed (CQSH), cases discharged (CDIS), cases acquitted (CAQ) by the court during 2016-2020 is as follows:
